We are funded through membership and United Way donations. CKM has an active PTSA to support programs, projects, and activities that benefit students and staff school-wide. CKM's PTSA maintains an active affiliation with the California State PTA, which entitles our organization to specific benefits such as low-cost insurance. Bylaws provide CKM's PTSA with a governance structure and guidelines for operation.

Your time commitment is minimal. We have General Association meetings five times per year. We will ask for willing volunteers for committee work and events. Some members support the PTSA with their membership while others commit through a more engaged approach. It is your choice on how much time you can give.

Meeting Dates-The PTSA General Association Meeting is held five times per year. Virtual Meetings will be held if the school goes into Distance Learning. All parents, students, teachers, administrators, and school staff have an open invitation to attend the General Association meetings. The PTSA Board Members meet most months during the school year. Each General Association Meeting will focus on a topic of interest for our members and school families, such as student health and safety, district updates, school programs, or advanced education. Our meetings are held from **6:30 pm-8:00pm at the CKM Media Center/Library or Virtual**, usually on the fourth Monday of the month, unless announced otherwise. We encourage you to join us at these meetings. It is a great way to meet new parents, be involved in your student's school, and learn what's happening on campus or in the district.

Essential Items Funded By PTSA

College Scholarships and Teacher Grants

Annually, the PTSA awarded over \$3,000 in grants to our teacher members to help complement academic offerings and supplement student enrichment and college scholarships to senior members.
